Mater Academy St. Cloud is a two-story, K-8 public charter school in St. Cloud, Fla. The \$8 million facility, designed to accommodate about 600 students, is Phase I of a planned K-12 campus.

The project program includes typical classrooms, science, art and music labs, food prep area lunch room and a multipurpose spill-out area. The building is composed of

four clearly identifiable program elements assembled linearly: the administration/front entrance element; the circulation core; the classroom wing; and the cafeteria component.

Each of these elements has its own unique characteristics, but share similar detailing, materiality and scale. Assembled together, these elements convey the school's programmatic and operational hierarchy while preserving the effect of a singular building. ■
